## FUTURE OF THE CLUB

It was announced early in the year that the club lease would not be renewed beyond March 2026. This situation has changed and an independent management company, known as “The Range, Phesantekraal” has been established that will manage and run the shooting range in the future. The range will now be run independently on a commercial basis. The DSK chairman and vice-chairman may well serve in an advisory position on the exco of the new company, but this is still under discussion.

The Durbanville Shooting Club administration will continue as before and its members will still be able to use the shooting range as in the past, but the club will no longer be responsible for the general running of the facility. Major improvements are planned and the range will be open more often during the week, which will benefit our members who cannot always shoot on a Saturday.

The annual Durbanville Shooting Club membership fee, now including access to “The Range”, will allow members, beyond regular club membership benefits, to apply for dedicated sport and hunter status, load various activities online and will entitle you to use the shooting range on a regular basis. It has also been decided that the R20 “Day fee” will fall away.
